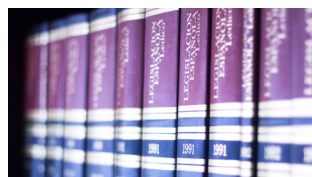
## NLSIU launches regulatory governance project
