# The New NLS BA (Hons) Programme for AY 2025-26



In December 2024, we announced our **new NLS BA (Hons) Programme** — a three-year offering with an additional fourth year for research. As NLSIU develops into a multidisciplinary university, this programme is an organic development from over 35 years of experience in offering the integrated 5-year BA LLB (Hons) programme. It builds on existing faculty expertise, and we look forward to further diversify our faculty over the next few years. We take this new step with the hope that faculty and cohorts of students in diverse degree programmes will give and take from each other's learnings and values, and add meaningfully to holistic learning at NLS.

The first cohort of 60 students will be admitted in July 2025 through the NLSAT-BA, a national level entrance examination on April 27, 2025.

Justice E.S. Venkataramiah Centennial Memorial Lecture



# NLSIU has a FIFA Standard Turf Football Field!

As part of upgrading our core infrastructure, the sports facilities on campus are undergoing a two-phase renovation. Ahead of the new year 2025, we completed Phase I of this project — construction of a turf football field as per FIFA standards. We began Phase II of this project this month, with the construction of a six-lane, 400-meter running track.

#### **Campus Expansion**

We are embarking on the largest expansion of the NLSIU campus since our inception in 1986!

After four years of negotiations with the Government of Karnataka, we are pleased to announce a 30-year land lease agreement with the Bangalore University, securing an additional land parcel of seven acres in Nagarabhavi which will help expand our campus. We will also be undertaking the renovation of both the Old Academic Block and the New Academic Block this year, and are investing in significantly strengthening the sewage and water treatment infrastructure of the campus.
