**Recruitment for Chair Professor Department of Revenue in the National Law School
of India University, Bangalore**

The National Law School of India University (NLSIU) was established in 1987 and is a premier institution for legal excellence in India. The University has remained the undoubted leader in legal education and research in India and has been ranked **first** among Law Universities in the Ministry of Human Resource Development's National Institute Ranking Framework for the last seven years.

NLSIU along with the Department of Revenue, Government of India, has established the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** to recognize scholars and teachers in the field of taxation law, anti-corruption, and foreign exchange regulation, with the aim of producing high quality research, strengthening pedagogy, engaging in public policy dialogue and attracting world class researchers and academicians to the University. The **Department of Revenue (DOR) Chair Professor** will engage in research in areas of direct and indirect tax laws to (i) strengthen the working capacity of DoR in areas of legal and policy research, (ii) to build and maintain an updated knowledge database in tax law and related areas, (iii) to act as a 'think-tank' for DoR, and (iv) to provide necessary legal advice on demand and to support DoR in capacity building.

Role of the Professor

The Chair Professor will lead research and scholarship and mentor faculty in taxation at the University. The Chair Professor will participate in the teaching of taxation law to undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral students. The Chair Professor will be expected to publish high-quality research in taxation law in top ranking publications, globally. The Chair Professor will also extend training to DoR officers in Laws by way of seminars, conferences organized by NLSIU from time to time, and provide legal advice and capacity building to DoR personnel.

Appendix A

NATIONAL LAW SCHOOL OF INDIA UNIVERSITY, BANGALORE MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR RECRUITMENT TO REGULAR POSTS OF TEACHERS IN THE UNIVERSITY (PER UGC REGULATIONS, 2018)¹

I. Essential Qualifications for All Posts

1. A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed).
2. A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and master's level for the Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Differently-abled categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions.
3. A relaxation of 5%, may be provided, to the Ph.D Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
4. The eligibility marks of 55% marks or an equivalent grade in a point scale prescribed by these regulations and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.

II. Eligibility for various Posts

1. PROFESSOR (LAW)

A.

- (i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the UGC Regulations, 2018;
- (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as an Assistant Professor /Associate Professor/Professor, and/or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate,

OR

- B.** An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institution/ industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge of direct or indirect tax law or business law or public finance or public policy, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

OR

- C. Distinguished experts who have made remarkable contributions in their professions in tax law and allied disciplines. They must have proven expertise in their specific profession or role with at least 15 years of service/experience/research, preferably at a senior level. A formal academic qualification is not considered essential for this position if they have exemplary professional practice along these lines. Preference shall be given to officers of CBIC and CBDT with relevant experience and seniority.
